DATE and VENUE:

Niigata City is located on the northwest coast of Honshu, Japan's largest island. The city is accessible by two main means of transportation: by plane via Niigata International Airport, or by train via JR Niigata Station. Direct international flights are available to and from Seoul, Shanghai, and Taipei while domestic flights connect Niigata with many major cities in Japan. The JR Joetsu Shinkansen (bullet train) can take you from Tokyo Station to JR Niigata Station in about 2 hours.

The conference venue, TOKI MESSE, is located approx. 2 km from JR Niigata Station and can be reached in 15 minutes by bus or 5 minutes by taxi. From Niigata Airport, it is about 20 minutes by taxi.
